This is her personal account of her grandfather's life, his studies as a young man in Paris in the 1920's, involvement with the Paris Expo in 1925, his passionate work in rebuilding and strengthening China, why he is called the first Chinese Art Deco Architect and how his life devastatingly changed after fleeing China in 1947 and coming to America.

But Delaunay was more than a fashion designer, working on costumes for the Ballets Russes production of Cleopatre and cofounding the art movement known as Orphism with her husband, painter Robert Delaunay. The 20th century was a time in which the barriers between art and design and between women and the world began to fall.
